



Protea Sauvignon Blanc 2010



The grapes for this wine come from L'Ormarins, Franschhoek – a warmer climate, and from our other farm Elandskloof in Villiersdorp – a cool climate, the 2nd highest vineyards in South Africa. Elandskloof also has very flinty, granite soils. The warm climate offers good fruitiness – tropical characters. Cool climate gives aromatics – green pepper, asparagus. The wine is unwooded.

TASTING NOTES

Bold tropical fig and gooseberry aromas with floral, grassy note underneath. Gravelly flint entry onto the palate with a zesty lime cordial and white pepper bite. Crisp and fresh with typically lively acidity. Good length of flavour on a lean – but fruited – frame.
